Upfront Discount is 25% for 2018.

Fund Mod went from .622 to .658

BUDGET: Excess WC

We have renewed the Excess WC at a \$500,000 self-insured retention. That means on every WC claim submitted to the Fund we are responsible for the first \$500,000. No increase on Excess WC

<u>2018 – 2019 INSURED</u>

Insured overall increase without coverage changes is 3.5% No increase on Cyber Policies Significant exposure changes for several BOE. Additional Vehicles, added CAP for Long Hill and Verona BOE, few small ADA changes.
